The South Whitley Town Council met for work session on Tuesday, January 9th 2018 at 5:30 P.M. in the Town Hall Board Room. Those present were Council President Randy Cokl, Councilman Les Hoffman, Councilman Bill Boggs, Waste Water Operator Kent Slater, Marshal Mikel Van Devender, Attorney Gregg Hockemeyer and Clerk-Treasurer Janet Howard.


President Cokl mentioned that he had met with Randy Hollar, Jeff Beer and Riley Hollenbaugh from Whitley County EDC to discuss loaning money at a low rate from the EDC Red Leg Fund. He also mentioned that he met with Carrie Hoffman to look into an incentive package for the Whitko High School to stay in town. There was discussion on putting a package together to present to the School Board and asked Attorney Hockemeyer if he would work up a proposal to present to the board this Thursday. Attorney Hockemeyer stated he would and asked President Cokl to check with IMPA to see if they would have some kind of Economic Incentive as well. Attorney Hockemeyer stated that the council would have to make a motion in a regular meeting to pass this.

Mr. Slater mentioned that Donohue is looking into a Grant through FEMA for the cost of flood protection at the sewage plant and the DLZ will probably have an on call agreement for sidewalks at the next meeting. Mr. Slater mentioned that Steve Carter would be at the February 13th Council meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:29 PM by President Cokl.




President, Randy Cokl
