


SOUTH WHITLEY TOWN COUNCIL PUBLIC MEETING

The Pubic Meeting was called to order at 6:34 P.M. by President Randy Cokl. Present was President Cokl, Councilman Hoffman, Councilman Boggs and Clerk-Treasurer Janet Howard.

President Cokl was the only Council member on the stage for the meeting and opened the meeting by telling a little history of the EMS service in South Whitley and how it has changed. He also stated that he invited County Commissioner George Schrupf to the meeting in May and had just heard back from him by email a week prior to the meeting that he wouldn't be able to attend, so he then reached out to Commissioner Tom Western who he did not hear back from him so he wasn't sure whether he was coming or not. If he had known that Commissioner Western wasn't going to show he would have reached out to Commissioner Don Amber to attend the meeting to hear the concerns of the South Whitley residents on the response time of our current EMS service with Parkview but could not do so because of the open door law.

Also attending was Sheriff Gatton and the head of Whitley County dispatch Janelle Schmidt. Sheriff Gatton was in attendance at the meeting to give his support from the Whitley County Sheriff's department to dispatch for Lutheran EMS. There were other comments and questions during the meeting and Councilman Cokl recommended at the end of the meeting to call your Whitley County Commissioners and voice their concerns. Councilman Cokl also stated that he will be on the agenda at the next Commissioners meeting Monday, June 19th at 1:00 P.M. in Columbia City and would like to ask everyone to come and show their support.


Meeting was adjourned at 7:48 P.M.
