
The South Whitley Town Council and town employees met for the worksession on May 12, 2020 at 3:30 -4:00 p.m. in the Town Board Room. Present were Les Hoffman, President , Randy Cokl, Councilman, Brock Waterson Councilman, Mikel Vandevender, Kent Slater, Jason Keim, Pam Waller, Brent Hull and Pamela Hoffman-Clerk Treasurer.

Employees engaged in a good discussion with council members over several issues pertaining to their jobs. Council had areas of concern, flushing hydrants, electronic water meter reads installed, status of Ron receiving his certification for water plant. Possible moving of burn pile from Gale Hagen Park to East Water Tower.

Kent reported that the wastewater plant new hire will need to know all duties in town, wastewater, water, electric, snow plow, pick up limbs, read meters and water flowers as well as get certifications for the wastewater plant.

The Council asked Town Marshal Mikel Vandevender for a spreadsheet for town lights that need replaced that the police department identifies and present to next town council meeting. Mikel presented a quote for centralizing cameras.

Paul Elling attended during the 4:00 – 4:30 p.m. session, presenting Ottenweller Pay App #18 for \$253,656.25, to be approved at the 4:30 general council meeting. He expects a mid-July completion of the wastewater plant project except for restoration.
